I, David McGuigan (the "Petitioner"), as the duly appointed foreign representative, as defined in section 101(24) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), of Tokio Marine Europe Insurance Limited (formerly known as The Tokio Marine & Fire Insurance Company (U.K.) Limited) (the "Scheme Company" or "Debtor") in this case under chapter 15 of the Bankruptcy Code, hereby file the following list in accordance with Rule 1007(a)(4) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure of the United States:

**Administrators in Foreign Proceedings of the Debtor**

The Scheme Company has proposed a scheme of arrangement pursuant to Part 26 of the Companies Act 2006 of England and Wales (the "Scheme"). The Scheme was

sanctioned by the High Court of Justice of England and Wales (the “English Court”) on April 15, 2011 and became effective on April 15, 2011. This is the only current foreign proceeding, as defined in section 101(23) of the Bankruptcy Code, respecting the Scheme Company, of which the Petitioner is aware.

The Scheme Company was also subject to another scheme of arrangement (the “WFUM Pools Scheme”) which was sanctioned by the English Court on September 17, 2007, and was granted recognition as a foreign main proceeding under chapter 15 of the Bankruptcy Code on October 23, 2007. The WFUM Pools Scheme in respect of the Scheme Company’s participation was declared complete on November 19, 2010.

The Scheme sanctioned by the English Court is the subject of the Verified Petition Under Chapter 15 For Recognition Of A Foreign Proceeding And Motion for Permanent Injunction filed by the Petitioner contemporaneously with the Official Form 1 Petition on July 18, 2011.


**Entities Against Whom Provisional Relief Is Sought Under 11 U.S.C. § 1519**
